

## **Swan Hill Regional Livestock Exchange**

## PRIME CATTLE MARKET REPORT 16th March 2017

Swan Hill Regional Livestock Exchange held its fortnightly Prime Cattle sale with a yarding of 900 cattle of mixed quality. Most of the regular buyers were present and prices remained firm to slightly dearer across most weights and grades of stock.

A limited supply of finished vealers saw prices range from firm to 8 cents dearer on the last market. Yearling steers and heifers remained firm with the plainer types suited to feedlotters and restockers meeting strong competition. A large consignment of well bred Charolais cattle from Wilcannia ranging between 310 and 390kg sold to solid rates, ranging between 350c/kg and 370c/kg topping at 399c/kg.

A quality offering of cows saw most prices range between 190c/kg and 225c/kg with the best heavy cows over 600kg topping at 244c/kg
