Prime Sheep & Lamb Sale 9th February 2017

Yarding 10778 Lambs 9446 Sheep

Swan Hill Regional Livestock Exchange held our regular fortnightly Prime Sheep sale yarding a total of 10778 head. . Buyer competition was keen with all the major export and domestic processors represented.

Lamb numbers dominated with just a small offering of sheep to mark the start of the regular fortnightly markets at Swan Hill. Lamb guality was good, with a run of heavy crossbred lambs penned that had been supplementary fed. Dorpers accounted for a high percentage of the trade weight offering. Heavy Lambs sold \$5-\$8/head. Light Lambs & Sheep sold at \$10 up on previous fortnightly quotations.

Bidding reached a top of \$196 for heavy export lambs, and it was one of three pens to sell above \$190/head. This was followed by a handful of sales from \$175 to \$186/head. The bulk best of the lambs suiting domestic orders and weighing up to 26kg cwt sold from \$150 to \$170/head. On a carcass basis most sales of well finished slaughter lambs were tracking in a range of 600c to 650c/kg. Local restockers

paid from \$81 to \$112/head for light lambs to turn-out, with the bigger runs of store lambs mainly being Dorpers.

The sheep offering was limited to smaller pen-lots of Merinos and Dorper ewes, with small drafts of crossbreds available.
