With young lambs expected to come in over the next month we saw a reduced number of older lambs at this fortnight Seep and Lambs sale at the Swan Hill Regional Livestock Exchange.

Our regular buyers had less finished heavier weight lambs to select from last fortnight which saw some price improvements in lighter stock.

One pen of extra heavy lambs reached over \$200/head while the remainder sold between \$170 to \$198/head.

Major domestic orders were filled with Trade weight lambs selling from \$135/head to \$164/head while processors sought the lighter merino lambs up \$5-\$8/head.

We saw a token offering of new season lambs selling up to \$127/head.

Bidding on mutton saw similar prices to a fortnight ago.
