Prime Sheep & Lamb Sale 16th June 2016

Swan Hill Regional Livestock Exchange prime lamb market on Thursday 16th June saw a yarding of 8,000 head presented. Although quality was similar to our last sale; overall prices were at a slightly cheaper rate.

Heavy and trade lambs were well represented and sold up to \$5.00/head cheaper. Prices for light trade and dorper lambs remained firm.

A yarding of exceptional quality merino lambs were presented which sold firm from last fortnights quotations, whilst plainer types were back by \$5.00/head.

Prices for sheep were up; and sold \$7.00 to \$8.00/head dearer for heavy mutton.
