Prime Sheep & Lamb Sale 22nd September 2016

Wet weather conditions at the Swan Hill Regional Livestock Exchange prime lamb sale on Thursday 22nd September resulted in a decreased yarding of 4,821 new season lambs, 1,114 old lambs and 1,139 mutton. Competition from start to finished was very strong with most of the yarding selling to the major processors.

Heavy sucker lambs met strong demand increasing by \$5.00 to \$8.00/head with the top pen from BT & JR Sinapius of Natya selling at \$187.00/head. Trade sucker lambs also saw increased prices, lifting by excesses of \$10.00/head. With limited numbers of old season lambs, prices remained steady, topping the market at \$158.00/head. Competition was for the limited numbers of merino lambs saw price increases of \$5.00/head. Mutton prices saw heavy sheep increase by \$5.00 to \$8.00/head while light sheep remained firm.
