Prime Cattle Sale 30th August 2018

Drought affected cattle continued their run here at the Swan Hill Regional Livestock Exchange in a reduced yarding this week. Agents gathered 1544 head including some very good supplementary fed stock from around the area. Two export processors competed for the heavy export cattle helping to lift Bullock & Steer prices up by 10c/kg-20c/kg. Modest improvements were seen across all other categories when compared to last fortnights market. Trade weight Steers & Heifers consistently produced prices that hovered around 300c/kg whilst light cattle remained tight around 200c/kg. Cow prices remained strong thanks to processors paying premium for well covered stock.
