

## Swan Hill Regional Livestock Exchange

### Prime Sheep & Lamb Sale 7<sup>th</sup> February 2019



Swan Hill Regional Livestock Exchange started the year off with a Sheep sale seeing Agents yard 6270 head in a challenging market. A tough start to the selling season saw heavy lambs following industry trends selling between \$160/head to \$194/head or 570c/kg-600c/kg. The better shaped trade lamb quotations improved slightly selling to over 600c/kg. Light lambs continue to trade at a discount, lacking competition as re-stockers and feeders bid conservatively. Our Mutton market continued to challenge agents bringing prices ranging from \$65/kg to \$90/kg topping at \$112/kg.
