Prime Cattle Sale 28th February 2019

Swan Hill Regional Livestock Exchange opened its doors to a new era at this week's Prime Cattle Market. Agents gathered 1021 head to start the year off strong. The overall yarding consisted of everything from heavy beef types through to small calves. Re-stocker & Feedlot support was there for the majority of the market as the supply of finished cattle was limited. The most enthusiastic bids come for good domestic slaughter ready calves and export cattle. Again due to the lack of any rain relief a high number of females were seen this week. With prices remaining firm from the last sale in 2018 Export Cattle topped at 292c/kg for stock over 480kg whilst small calves sold under \$100 each.
