

# Swan Hill Regional Livestock Exchange



## Prime Cattle Sale 6<sup>th</sup> of June 2019

Although there was a larger yarding at the SHRLE than last fortnight, an increase in lightweight cattle was more noticeable than prime cattle available to processors. The market prices were generally firmer with Export recording gains of up to 17c and Trade/Veal seeing a lift of up to 40c from last sale's tops.

Well bred pens of young cattle were sought after by feedlots and those looking to restock with the price reflecting the demand. Bidders were more selective with the plainer lots though, but reasonable prices were still obtainable.
