Agents yarded slightly over 1300 head at the weeks Prime Cattle sale in Swan Hill. As the season becomes less favourable, a decline in quality was evident when compared to last fortnight. With the absence of some processor, supermarket & feedlot orders, prices were discounted across all categories with condition determining the extent. As restocker competition declines with the season, lighter secondary types showed the sharpest decline. Competition for processor heavy cows remained solid and in line with tends across the region.
