Strong competition across all categories offered, pushed prices at this week's SHRLE Sheep & Lamb sale. Very good line ups of both stock and buying groups saw most lamb prices jump considerably when compared to last fortnight's quotations. Heavy Lambs sold a \$10/head to \$15/head better while Trade Lambs sold to \$25/better. The heaviest lambs topped at \$243. Limited supplies of light lambs & Mutton were on offer however prices were again significantly dearer on last fortnight.
